RESIDENTS DONATE TO VAUGHAN HEALTH CARE FOUNDATION

VAUGHAN, ON – At a Council meeting held February 27, Mayor Michael Di Biase and Mr. Michael DeGasperis, Vice President of the Vaughan Health Care Foundation, accepted cheques totalling \$12,500 for Vaughan’s proposed health care facility.

Mr. Attilio Lio donated \$10,000 to the Foundation on behalf of his family, and Mr. Claudio Tersigni and Mr. Pino Furfaro of the City of Vaughan International Soccer Tournament (COVI) presented a \$2,500 cheque.

“I would like to thank these gentlemen for their generous support of our proposed health care facility,” said Mayor Di Biase. “These partnerships and community involvement will help to achieve our goal of establishing a first-class health care campus in Vaughan. We need emergency care and we’re the only city in Canada with a population of 240,000 that doesn’t have its own hospital.”
